Title or Subject: RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF A WASTEWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN AMENDMENT FOR THE CONNECTION OF THE BLACK OAK GOLF COURSE CLUB HOUSE TO THE WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY LONG VALLEY SEWERAGE SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the Black Oak Golf Course is presently being constructed under an agreement with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection which, amongst other things, requires that sanitary wastewater generated from appurtenant facilities, including the Club House, be limited to 2,000 gallons per day and be treated by an in ground wastewater treatment (septic) system; and

WHEREAS, the West Morris Regional High School District (WMRHSD) in cooperation with the Washington Township Municipal Utilities Authority (WTMUA) constructed a sanitary sewerage system along Bartley Road which anticipated flow from lots along Bartley Road; and

WHEREAS, said sewerage system and the WTMUA's Long Valley Wastewater Treatment Plant have the capacity to handle sewage flow from parcels along Bartley Road and the Black Oak Golf Course Club House; and

WHEREAS, the Washington Township Committee agrees with the West Morris Regional High School District, the Washington Township Municipal Utilities Authority and the Washington Township Board of Health that such connection would be in the best interest of the residents of Washington Township, both environmentally and financially; and

WHEREAS, to allow the connection of the Black Oak Golf Course Club House to the Washington Township Municipal Utilities Authority's Long Valley Sewerage System, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection must allow a modification to the Township Wastewater Management Plan (WMP).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Washington, in the County of Morris, and the State of New Jersey as follows:

1. By its adoption of this resolution, the Township Committee of the Township of Washington endorses an effort by the WMRHSD and the WTMUA to seek a modification of the Township Wastewater Management Plan (WMP) to allow connection of the Black Oak Golf Course Club House to the WTMUA's Long Valley Sewerage System; and
2. To shown its support, the Township Committee will have a Committeeperson attend a meeting (or meetings) with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection.
