FINAL BUDGET DISCUSSION

The operating expense budget was reduced by \$112,000, bringing the tax rate increase to 1.39%. The Capital Budget came in at \$783,400, which includes a new ambulance for the First Aid Squad and a new fire truck for the Long Valley Fire Department. Prior funds will be used for road repairs to include Wehrli Road and Upper Fairview Avenue.

<u>Comm. Kennedy</u> raised the subject of reducing the fees associated with our current Alarm Ordinance. This will be discussed in more detail at the March 14, 2012 Work Session.

Police, Fire and First Aid portable and mobile radio maintenance was discussed. It was decided to create a special line item for maintenance for these radios.

<u>Mayor Short</u> stated that the 2012 budget would be ready for introduction at the March 14, 2012 Work Session.

Susan Coscia's appointment as an Alternate Member of the Recreation Committee was discussed.
