**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON,
COUNTY OF MORRIS, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY TO
AMEND CHAPTER 168, SOLID WASTE, OF THE CODE OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Washington, in the County of Morris, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 168, Solid Waste, Article I, Recycling, Section 168-2, Residential requirements, Subsection D, of the Code of the Township of Washington, Morris County, New Jersey is hereby amended to read as follows:

“D. If deposited at curbside for pickup pursuant to a contract with a private recycler, recyclables shall be prepared in accordance with the recycler's specifications except for yard waste. Yard waste placed at the curb or along the street, pursuant to pickup by a private recycler, must be containerized (placed in a trash can, bucket, bag or other vessel to prevent spilling or blowing into the street) and be placed at the street no more than seven (7) days prior to a scheduled collection, and shall not be placed closer than 10 feet from any storm drain inlet. Placement of such yard waste at the curb or along the street at any other time or in any other manner is a violation of this ordinance.”

SECTION 2. All ordinances of the Township of Washington that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
