

ORDINANCE NO. RO-17-05

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON TO
AMEND THE ENFORCEMENT PROVISION OF VARIOUS
ORDINANCES**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Washington, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. RO-10-05 regarding illicit connections to the storm sewer system, is hereby amended in the following section only:

“SECTION 4. Enforcement. All police officers of the Township, regular and special, the Department of Public Works Superintendent or his/her duly authorized designee, the Health Officer or his/her duly authorized designee, the Zoning Officer and/or his/her duly authorized designee and the Township Engineer and/or his/her duly authorized designee, are hereby given full power and authority and are charged with the duty to enforce all provisions of this article.”

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. RO-12-05 regarding the feeding of wildlife, is hereby amended in the following section only:

“SECTION 4. Enforcement. All police officers of the Township, regular and special, the Department of Public Works Superintendent or his/her duly authorized designee, the Health Officer or his/her duly authorized designee, the Zoning Officer and/or his/her duly authorized designee and the Township Engineer and/or his/her duly authorized designee, are hereby given full power and authority and are charged with the duty to enforce all provisions of this article.”

SECTION 3. Chapter 114, Littering, Section 114-11, Enforcement, violations and penalties, Paragraph A, Enforcement, is hereby amended to read as follows:

“A. Enforcement. All police officers of the Township, regular and special, the Department of Public Works Superintendent or his/her duly authorized designee, the Health Officer or his/her duly authorized designee, the Zoning Officer and/or his/her duly authorized designee and the Township Engineer and/or his/her duly authorized designee, are hereby given full power and authority and are charged with the duty to enforce all provisions of this article.”

SECTION 4. Chapter 46, Animals, Article I, Dog licensing, Section 46-13, Enforcement, of the Code of the Township of Washington, Morris County, New Jersey is hereby amended and supplemented to read as follows:

“§46-13. Enforcement. All police officers of the Township, regular and special, and the animal control officer and his/her authorized agents are hereby given full power and authority and are charged with the duty to enforce all provisions of this article. In addition, the Department of Public Works Superintendent or his/her duly authorized designee, the Health Officer or his/her duly authorized designee, the Zoning Officer and/or his/her duly authorized designee and the Township Engineer and/or his/her duly authorized designee, are hereby given full power and authority and are charged with the duty to enforce the provisions of § 46-15.”

SECTION 5. All Ordinances of the Township of Washington which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 6. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval and publication as required by law.
