New Business

- **Historic Preservation Conference:** Tomorrow June 4, 2015 in Mount Laurel. Walk-ins are \$100.
- 244 Flocktown Road. The property is on the State and National register and the Washington Township stone house survey. New property owners are closing on the property tomorrow June 4, 2014. The new property owners will need to demolish some of the stone structures on the property because they are in disrepair and are prohibitively costly to repair. The property is not in a historic preservation district so the HPC does not have jurisdiction over this property. The stone structures will be demolished on Friday June 6. Will need to notify the State that these structures need to be removed from the register.
- Califon Historic Preservation Committee: Califon has formed an advisory committee
 for historic preservation. They have reached out to use our Design Guidelines. We think
 that they can use it as a general guide to create a customized document for their historic
 district.
- **Historic Preservation Awards.** Decided on recipients of 2015 historic preservation awards. Gregg Forsbrey volunteered to present the awards at a Township meeting. He will let Eileen know when his available.
