Title or Subject:AUTHORIZE THE CANCELLATION OF SMALL BALANCES AND CREDITS AND THE
ANNUAL SALE OF DELINQUENT TAXES FOR 2012 AND SET RATE OF INTEREST ON
DELINQUENT TAXES – 2013

WHEREAS, the Tax Collector recommends to the Township Committee that the necessary administrative action be taken to authorize the Tax Collector to cancel any property tax overpayment or delinquency of less than \$10.00 and to conduct the annual sale of delinquent taxes for the calendar year 2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Washington, Morris County, New Jersey, that the Tax Collector is authorized to cancel any property tax overpayment or delinquency of less than \$10.00 and to conduct the annual sale of delinquent taxes for the calendar year 2012; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the rate of interest to be paid upon delinquent taxes for the year 2013 shall be fixed at the rate of eight (8) percent per annum to \$1,500.00, and any amount in excess of \$1,500.00 shall be fixed at the rate of eighteen (18) percent per annum until total delinquency is paid regardless of year. However, interest shall not be collected upon taxes that are not delinquent over ten (10) days. After the ten (10) day "grace period," interest reverts back to the due date.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a penalty of up to six (6) percent per annum may be charged on any delinquency in excess of \$10,000.00, tax and interest, if not paid by the end of the fiscal year.
