
READ THIS NOTICE CAREFULLY

Keep these papers until shipment is delivered to you by the Railroad Company. In the enclosed bill-of-lading the Transportation Company acknowledges receipt of all **the articles in good condition**. If any breakage occurs it will be due to rough handling or to causes beyond our control, and the Transportation Company must be held responsible.

Do not fail to examine the shipment carefully before taking it away from the railroad station, so that any concealed damage may be discovered before goods are removed from the freight house.

IN CASE OF DAMAGE OR LOSS

Have the freight agent at your station make notation on the freight receipt showing the exact condition, in which the shipment is delivered to you.

To comply with ruling of Interstate Commerce Commission the freight receipt, properly noted, must be sent us immediately. At the same time, write us in detail, giving number and description of parts lost or broken, so that we can replace shipment.

WHEN CAST IRON PIPE IS RECEIVED BROKEN

Have the freight agent at your station make notation on freight receipt, showing the exact condition of the pipe, **do not take the broken pipe away from the station or freight depot**. Send us the freight receipt, showing notation of the number and size of pieces broken, and we will make a replace shipment without charge to you, **providing you do not accept the broken pipe but leave it at the station**. You may, of course, accept any part of the pipe shipment that is delivered in good condition.
