

Plans for the Local Defense and Military Training as Formulated by the Home Guard Committee of The New Jersey Committee on Public Safety

Approved by C. W. Barber, Adjutant General of the State of New Jersey and by the Executive Committee of the New Jersey Committee on Public Safety

The Executive Head of each Municipality shall have charge of the organization herein recommended.

The following committees shall be appointed:

1. Committee on Home Defense and Military Training.
2. Committee on Woman's Service.
3. Committee on Census.
4. Committee on Finance.
5. Committee on Secret Service.
6. Committee on Publicity.

1. Committee No. 1 will have charge of military training and general patrol and home defense duties.

2. Committee No. 2 is expected to organize the women of the community for all the usual "Red Cross" functions, but it is hoped that it will have the broader scope of ascertaining to what extent the women of the town can take the place of men in occupations usually filled by men.

3. Committee No. 3 is expected to make a complete census of the municipality to ascertain the extent to which every citizen is able and willing to serve the community, in military service or out of it, in case of war.

4. Committee No. 4 is to raise all necessary funds.

5. Committee No. 5 is to be appointed by the Chief Executive of the municipality and the members of this committee are to be known by him only. The work of this committee is to be reported to the Chief Executive, who, in turn, shall report to the Adjutant General anything which he, the Chief Executive, may deem to be of sufficient importance.

6. Committee No. 6 is to be the only vehicle of communication to the public.
