CAPITAL ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF VARIOUS ROADS IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING \$975,000 THERFOR AND PROVIDING THAT SUCH SUM SO APPROPRIATED SHALL BE RAISED FROM NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION GRANTS AND FROM THE TOWNSHIP'S CAPITAL FUND BALANCE

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Washington, in the County of Morris, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1 The sum of \$975,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of the improvements authorized and described in Section 2 of this ordinance. Said appropriation shall be raised from New Jersey Department of Transportation grants for Pleasant Grove Road in the amount of \$200,000 and East Valley Brook Road in the amount of \$210,000. In addition, the sum of \$565,000 is hereby appropriated from the Township's Capital fund balance.

SECTION 2. The improvements hereby authorized are the improvement of various roads and locations in and by the township, including, without limitation, Pleasant Grove Road for approximately 3,000 feet, Wehrli Road for approximately 2,525 feet, East Valley Brook Road for approximately 5,210 feet and Fairview Avenue for approximately 5,000 feet, by the surfacing or resurfacing thereof, together with all storm water drainage facilities, inlets, manholes, sidewalks, curbing, speed tables, pavement markers, milling, structures, signage, site work, work and materials necessary therefore or incidental thereto.

SECTION 3. The said purposes described in Section 2 of this ordinance are not a current expense and are improvements which the Township may lawfully make as general improvements, and no part of the costs thereof have been or shall be specially assessed on property specially benefited thereby.

SECTION 4 The capital budget or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing all detail of the amended capital budget or temporary capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, are on file with the Township Clerk and are available for public inspection.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
