



**Animal Control.** The current animal control officer has resigned, the Township advertised for a replacement on the website and **Mr. Coppola** contacted surrounding towns to see if they were interested. One bid has been submitted and we are waiting for one more. The cost is approximately \$13,000 each year.

**Fire Prevention Bruce Tynan**, the current Fire Prevention Official, has resigned. Two individuals have expressed interest in the position. There have been no recommendations from the Fire Chiefs. **Mr. LiaBraaten** and **Mr. Coppola** will interview both applicants and make their recommendations to the Committee.

**JCP&L.** A few outages were reported this week. **Mayor Short** spoke with the JCP&L contact person. JCP&L Engineers are examining the failed wires. Restoration took over 12 hours. JCP&L will follow up with Mayor Short.

**Comm. Tobin** expressed his frustration and disappointment in JCP&L and their lack of attention. The time for band aids is over, a hard and fast repair is essential.

**Comm. Liabraaten** stated that he has averaged 1 power outage each month for the past 20 years. **Mayor Short** asked **Comm. LiaBraaten** to request a report from JCP&L to detail the number of power outages he has had. This information will provide support for future meetings and discussions.
