**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON,
COUNTY OF MORRIS, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY TO
MANDATE DIRECT DEPOSIT FOR MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES
PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 52:14-15f et. seq.**

WHEREAS, P.L. 2013 c. 28, authorizes local governments to mandate direct deposit for certain governmental employees effective after July 1, 2014; and

WHEREAS, P.L. 2013 c. 28 permits governing bodies to grant exemptions on such terms and conditions as they deem necessary.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Washington, in the County of Morris, and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. All full time employees and elected public officials who receive compensation from the Township of Washington are mandated to have direct deposit of their compensation as of September 19, 2014 in accordance with Chapter 28 P.L. 2013, as codified at N.J.S. A. 52:14-15f (b).

SECTION 2. Municipal employees may, in writing directed to the Township Administrator, request an exemption from the direct deposit mandate. Such requests shall be presented to the Township Committee within 30 days. The Township Committee may grant such an exemption by resolution for good cause.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency

SECTION 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage, adoption and publication according to law.
