TITLE OR SUBJECT: RATIFICATION OF MAILBOX/POST REPLACEMENT POLICY

WHEREAS, the Township of Washington has a long standing policy regarding replacement of mailboxes and/or posts damaged by snow removal operations; and

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to affirm and ratify that policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Washington, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that the following mailbox/post replacement policy is hereby ratified and affirmed.

“All damaged mailboxes and/or posts shall be inspected by the Department of Public Works personnel in order to determine whether the mailbox or post was directly hit by a Washington Township plow or other snow removal equipment and whether the mailbox/post had been properly installed in the first place. If the mailbox/post was damaged by the weight of the snow alone, the Township will not accept responsibility for replacement. If the mailbox/post was damaged by a direct hit by the Township equipment, a replacement post and/or mailbox, depending upon the damage sustained, will be supplied but not installed by the Township. The Township will purchase and have on hand a supply of standard regulation mailboxes and posts for this purpose. Anything above and beyond the foregoing shall be the sole responsibility of the resident.”
