- 4. Future Activities for the Committee:

Red Bull Soccer Trip – after some discussion it was decided that this trip, given the costs involved, would not attract enough participation to be feasible.

Sands Casino Trip – Ed and Mary will look into organizing this trip and report back to the committee at next meeting.

Crayola Factory Trip – Ryan will look into organizing this trip and report back to the committee at next meeting.

- 5. Grant possibilities for building and renewing trails may be coming available. Ryan will be attending a seminar on this subject and will bring information back to the committee for the next meeting.
- 6. Darlene mentioned some events that the Recreation Department has organized, "Walk With The Mayor" at Schooley's Mountain Park on June 4th and Movie Nights at Rock Spring Park during the course of the summer. Any money earned from concession stand sales during the movies will be devoted to installing handicap accessible playground equipment.

Darlene also reported that a sharp conflict has developed between the baseball travelling league and the baseball recreation league. The Mayor has intervened in the dispute and given individuals involved strong guidance and direction to settle the conflict.
