

RESIDENTIAL ADDITION APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Zoning approval must be obtained prior to submission to the Building Department

Only complete applications will be accepted and permits will be reviewed in datestamped order.

- 1. Three (3) sets of building plans. All drawings prepared by a New Jersey licensed design professional must be signed and sealed (2 of the 3 sets). Plans drawn by homeowner shall include their name, address & signature and must reside there.
- 2. Copy of contractor's current Contractor's Home Improvement Registration card.
- 3. Manila folder must be completed in full on front cover and signature on inside cover.
- 4. Area –Largest Floor, New Building Area & Volume of New Structure must be indicated on the manila folder and building sub-code form. Separate renovation cost from addition cost.
- 5. Completed applicable sub-code sections with estimated cost and signed by person performing work.
- 6. Include wiring diagram for electrical work (receptacles, switches, devices).
- 7. A plumbing riser diagram is required.
- 8. Framing detail is required, and the framing checklist is required at framing inspection. ResCheck is required.
- 9. Specifications for new/replacement heating units or wood/gas fireplaces are required as well as a Chimney Verification form signed by professional only. Manual J, D and S required for new HVAC units.
- 10. A survey is required to indicate location of exterior equipment and property lines.
- 11. For a new structure that exceeds 400 square feet of roof area:
 - Morris County Soil Conservation (Washington Twp) approval is required or Upper Delaware Soil Conservation (Mansfield Twp)
- 12. If you have a septic system health department approval is required.
- 13. Additions expanding the first floor footprint of the home will be responsible to pay a COAH fee before issuance of the permit Washington Township
